

Act VIII

Deputy Prime Ministers and MPs

Reasons for the Act

If someone leaves the country when they are in Parliament, it can throw the country into chaos temporarily. The introduction of Deputy Prime Ministers and MPs will mean that the country can carry on as normal after a change.

What the Act Entails

1. The position of Deputy Prime Minister, as well as Deputy MP for each State, will be officially founded.
2. The Deputy Prime Minister will be chosen by the Monarch from the Members of Parliament.
3. The position of Deputy MP will be chosen in consultation between the Monarch and the MP of that State from the citizens of that State.
4. Only people who wish to become Deputy Prime Minister or Deputy MP can be chosen for these roles.
5. In the event that there is no one willing to become Deputy Prime Minister or Deputy MP, the Monarch will hold these roles as Acting Deputy Prime Minister or Acting Deputy MP.

Act IX

Dismissal of Prime Ministers and MPs

Reasons for the Act

If the Prime Minister or an MP is not performing their duties adequately, the Monarch is currently unable to remove them from office. If this act is passed, it will mean the Monarch will be able to remove those not performing their duties.

What the Act Entails

1. The Monarch will be able to dismiss the Prime Minister, or a Member of Parliament, from office, if they judge them to not be performing their duties adequately.
2. The person being dismissed will get at least 24 hours warning beforehand.
3. Once someone is dismissed, they will be replaced by their deputy.
4. The dismissed Prime Minister shall retain their place in Parliament.
5. If the deputy does not wish to takeover the dismissed's position, or there is no deputy, then the Monarch will be acting for them.

6. If none of the MPs wish to take on the role of Prime Minister, then the Monarch will call an election, in which the dismissed Prime Minister cannot be elected.
7. If, within two weeks of an MP being dismissed, no one has taken their place in Parliament, the Monarch may revoke the Statehood of that region.
